PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS



COMMUNITY HABILITATION (ONEIDA & LEWIS COUNTY)

This service is offered to people who live with their family / caregivers or who live independently. Community Habilitation is designed to help strengthen skills and to achieve satisfying and rewarding connections and relationships. Services are provided in both community and home-based environments. Staff assists people to become more independent with daily living activities and helps people achieve other goals they consider important.

IN-HOME RESPITE

Support is provided in the home for families to help relieve them of their caregiving duties. Caregivers are matched with specially-trained staff to care for their qualifying individual so they can attend to other matters within or outside their home. Staff may assist the individual with daily living skills that the caregiver would otherwise support.

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RESPITE REIMBURSEMENT

This program allows families to hire their own respite worker to care for a qualified individual and have their care cost reimbursed with OPWDD funds through The Arc. Families pay their workers' wages and submit a monthly service log to The Arc for reimbursement up to an approved dollar amount.
