The Charles B. Wolkon Memorial Day Camp provides summertime fun and adventure for children ages 5 - 16 with a developmental disability, their siblings and their friends. **Kids' Camp** is held for two separate weeks surrounding summer school.

Campers enjoy indoor and outdoor cooperative activities including: arts and crafts, fishing, field sports, basketball, frog-catching, table games, karaoke, tie-dying and cooking. A barbeque picnic at camp and a group community outing are planned once each week. Children provide their own lunch and individual dietary needs are observed.

With support from staff, children learn and practice crucial social skills like playing appropriately, taking turns, sharing, holding conversations, making new friends and adjusting smoothly to changes throughout their day. Camp is a supported socialization/ recreational program.

Campships are available for children that are not Medicaid Waiver eligible through Operation Sunshine.
