#### Financials and Finance Committee Update / Anthony Battaglia

Finance Committee met yesterday via WebEx teleconferencing; numbers as of January 31, 2020 include assets of about \$1.8M, cash \$188,000 with \$165,000 unrestricted and \$23,000 Lynda Ford scholarship. Accounts Receivable \$7,200; Royal Alliance \$1.5M, restricted \$76,582; surplus of \$26,808. Anthony noted that Steve Caruso presented to the Finance Committee yesterday via WebEx; the fund balance is down about 10.29% as of March 13<sup>th</sup>; trailing performance by about 3.36% though holding well with a conservative mix. Discussion to look at possibley changing the policy ranges/target; will be scheduling a follow-up meeting with Steve Caruso to look at rebalancing outlines. There were no questions for Anthony.

#### Josh Turner Concert Updates / Rebecca Kearns

The concert has been rescheduled to Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>; 953 tickets sold to date, but no ticket sales yet with the new date announced; no more than 10 refunds have been issued; \$57,000 in total ticket sales, that number does not include sponsorships.

## Arc Update / Karen Korotzer

Steve Gassner noted the Arc NY will be reviewing all by-laws of all chapters state wide; both the agency and foundation by-laws will be sent to Kate Jerian, attorney for Arc NY.
