Treasurer's Report

Finance Committee met last week; balance statement as of 03/31/2019 reflects total current assets of \$146,246; total cash of \$135,465; pledges receivable of \$9,750; total long term investments of \$1,473,041; fund balance this period \$1,168,743; net surplus of \$44,892. Noted the annual contribution of \$50,000 in November 2018.

Reports / Mark Dudek, Chief Communications Officer

Annual Appeal net surplus of \$10,198 compared to \$10,680 in 2018 the first year over the \$10K mark; just over \$6,000 in 2016.

There is currently no final report on the Mayor's Gala to give yet; waiting on any other possible invoices or monies to come in; attendance was between 700 and 800 with about 400 attending on purchased tickets and the rest on sponsorship tickets; Mark noted the letter received from Jeannette Greene-Sisolak from Vestal, NY who attends the Mayor's Gala each year. The Mayor would like to have a final press conference once all is finalized; Mark thanked the committee members.

Pour Your Heart Out in Rome on Saturday, June 22nd at Teugega; Katie noted things are being finalized, up on sponsorships, a number of high end baskets for basket raffle; invites have gone out; News talk scheduled. Golf at Skenandoa on Monday, July 22nd; have reached out to the regular sponsors; \$600 per team this year; working with Dave Wood on a paid campaign.

Arctoberfest will be either the first or second Friday in October at Snow Ridge again this year; will be honoring Assemblyman Blankenbush and a person we support.
