We have been contacted by the Oneida County Public Health Department that one of our employees at 14 Arnold Avenue in Utica has tested positive for COVID-19. The last date of possible exposure to staff was on 3/12/2020. We have been told there is very low risk for exposure. They are not requiring that anyone (employees or people we support) be tested, isolated, or quarantined at this time.
