The Arc Oneida-Lewis Chapter's Kids'
Camp provides summertime fun and
adventure for children ages 5 to 12 with
a developmental disability, their siblings
and their friends. The Kids' Camp season
is scheduled around summer school and
will be held at the Charles B. Wolkon
Memorial Day Camp in Frankfort, NY.

Campers enjoy indoor and outdoor cooperative activities including: arts and crafts, field sports, basketball, table games, music, tie-dying and cooking. Children bring their own lunch, healthy snacks are provided and individual dietary needs are observed.

With support from staff, children learn and practice crucial social skills such as playing appropriately, taking turns, sharing, holding conversations, making new friends and adjusting smoothly to changes throughout their day. Day camp is a supported socialization/recreational program.

Camperships are available through Operation Sunshine for children who are not Medicaid Waiver eligible.

A central meeting place for drop-off and pick-up of campers may be arranged for those who need transportation.
